





Covid-19 impact



- In June we moved back to usual working arrangements, remote/hybrid work is still an option;
- All the planned investments have been made and deliveries (water treatment chemicals etc.) are on schedule;
- Consumption has increased in commercial sector compared to Q2 2020 due to the loosening of Covid-19 restrictions;
- Private customers' consumption has decreased slightly mainly due to lower consumption in apartment blocks;
- We expect a slight increase in the consumption of water services in the next quarters.







Total investments made in the 6 months of 2021: €4,1 mln

Investments into the network

- Reconstruction works on Poska and Roosikrantsi Streets, Kadaka Road
- Installing additional valves into the network

Investments into water and wastewater treatment plants WWTP:

- Reconstruction works on the mechanical treatment stage continued in Q2 and are scheduled to be completed at the end of July
- Upgrades in the main pumping station to enhance the resilience of wastewater treatment process

WTP:

- Reconstruction of Õismäe pumping station
- Reconstruction of the pipes at secondary chlorination units A and B















Water & Wastewater revenues in the 2nd quarter of 2021

Revenues, € million




Volumes, million m³
