

- The pipes were renovated on Järvevana Road, Sõle Street, Linnamäe Road, Raba Street, residential driveways in Õismäe, in Astangu area and in many other streets.



#### Water treatment plant:


- Installation of UV equipment in pumping stations





Average duration of water interruption per property






Rehabilitation of networks









### Water & wastewater revenues

### Volumes, million m<sup>3</sup>


